

# West Hill Manor House

*“A place worth saving, A place worth preserving, A place whose history needs to be told”*

West Hill is a historic manor house that was built between May, 1797 and July, 1799 for Samuel and Susanna Emlen, well known Quakers from Philadelphia.

In 2011, the Masonic Charity Foundation of New Jersey undertook a project to restore the first floor of the building to as original as possible.

West Hill was placed on the List of New Jersey Historic Sites in July 2013.



## About West Hill

Situated on 65 acres in Burlington Township New Jersey, it was built between 1797 and 1799 and is one of the few surviving examples of a Federal style home existent in Burlington County.
